MEDICAL, DENTAL AND VISION

Supplemental Medical, Vision and Dental: 100 percent paid by USLI

- Medical
 - Prescription drugs
 - Extended health care
 - Emergency travel assistance
- Vision
 - Exam every 24 months-adults
 - Exam every 12 months child(ren)
- Dental
 - Basic services
 - Major restorative
 - Preventive services

- Life and Disability
 - Accidental death, disease and dismemberment \$50,000
 - Dependent spouse life \$10,000
 - Dependent child life \$5,000
- Individual Disability Insurance
 - Individually underwritten
 - Starts on 91st day of disability
 - Pays 60 percent of your monthly salary







FINANCIAL AND RETIREMENT

- Profit sharing plan with up to 15 percent of annual compensation; vested over five years at 20 percent per year
- Discretionary performance bonus



FAMILY AND LIFESTYLE

- Adoption assistance at \$7,500 per year for qualified expenses
- Employee Assistance Program, though Health Advocate to assist with work life balance
- Access to Health Advocate services to assist with your healthcare needs
- Opportunity to request donations to charities or causes to which employees have personal connection through USLI's 501(c)3 CARE² Fund



DEVELOPMENT
